



SOAP MAKING DEMONSTRATION No 1

(Not a Workshop)

Keeping stuff out of landfill (limit 15)

Warning! Soap making is addictive.

You've raised your own animal, eaten nose to tail, fried everything you can think of in tallow, but still you have so much fat left over...

Come and learn how to make your own skin loving cold process soap using waste ingredients that usually get thrown away. We will show you how we turn beef fat and coffee grounds into a lovely soap. (The process is the same for most other fats and oils but the recipe will vary)

- The process takes about 45 minutes (the soap then sets for 12 hours and cures for 4 weeks but you don't need to wait around),
- You will be able to ask questions about soap making and learn some of the terminology and hopefully have the confidence to give it a go,
- You get to take home a guest sized sample soap that was made previously and is cured and ready to use.

SOAP MAKING DEMONSTRATION No 2 (Not a workshop)

Laundry Soap (limit 15 people)

Come and learn how to make your own grease stripping coconut based soap which is great for washing clothes or dishes.

This soap can then be grated fine and made into a clean, no junk, 3 ingredient washing powder for machine washing.

- The process takes about 45 minutes (the soap then sets for 12 hours and cures for 4 weeks),
- You will be able to ask questions about soap making and green cleaning,
- You get to take home a sample soap that was made previously (and is cured and ready to use) and a sample of washing powder.

SOAP MAKING DEMONSTRATION No 3

(Not a workshop)

Castile Liquid Soap (limit 15)

Learn how to make your own Liquid Castile Soap similar to a famous name brand but so much cheaper to make yourself.

- The making part takes 30 to 45 minutes,
- You will be able to watch and ask questions about liquid soap,
- The soap batter is then left in a slow cooker for about 3 hours with a stir every half hour. (You are welcome to pop in for a look.)
- Participants should return after 3 hours to see the end result and fetch their scoop of soap.
